The recent AGM saw me complete my sixth year as Secretary for Clwyd Vale Motor Club. However due to various commitments to various other projects the time had come to let some one else take over.

I was elected to the position as Club Secretary on the 21st of December 1999. It seems hard to believe now but at that time Clwyd Vale was on hard times. Perhaps the most difficult thing to deal with was the loss of Gareth W Jones. Gareth had been Secretary for about 33 years but had lost the fight with cancer in the middle of the year. This led to an Extraordinary General Meeting being called with Esmor Jones "volunteering" to act as Secretary till the AGM. Esmor had been a great help to Gareth and Clwyd Vale during that awful time so was a natural choice. Over all those previous years Gareth had been outstanding in his commitment to the Club, ably assisted by Hywel Edwards (Treasurer for around 30 years?). The Club owes Esmor a debt of gratitude for keeping things going for those sticky few months.

When it came to the AGM, volunteers were sought, few were found! Stuart Jones had been very instrumental in making sure that there were more than the (MSA) required minimum 25 members. Although I had been not doing a great deal with Motorsport in the years prior I had got a computer, had been on the Committee in the "old days" and had also been Competition Secretary. I was told I would be able to do the job no problem. Code for nobody else wanted to do it!!

In the following six years I always tried to follow the traditions of the Club and wherever

possible the methods of Gareth. Club rules might be boring and I am always asked, "do we have to stick to them?" The answer must always be yes, it gives structure and has kept things on the straight & narrow.

The growth of Clwyd Vale Motor Club is something I am very proud to have been a part of. The Night Naps & Club Nights kept us going month by month, we brought back the Clwydian Cars, very successfully, and Pete Dale kept us in the mainstream with the PCTs. Some of the older members and now me included, would like to remind Club members that it is a Motor Club not just a rally club so it's been good to see things improving if only slightly with the interest in PCTs etc. Last year saw Guy Woodcock putting his head above the parapet to act as Clerk of the Course on a road rally, The Farrington Trophy. This takes us back to where I started in 1979. I joined to do road rallies as a navigator. We really were thriving then and I can't help but think we are back on track for the good times.

One of the rewarding things of the last six years has been to see people join & then develop in ability and then to start giving back to the Club (out of choice!). Just as important is that they are enjoying their involvement. Richard Birch, Gareth Williams and John Broadhurst are good examples. I was rather humbled when at the AGM, Birchy thanked the older members (!) for the example set and the help given. The Club of the Year result validating what we do.

As I mentioned earlier I have only been a part of the growth of Clwyd Vale, most of the credit should go to the Committee, which is essentially a team, playing to it's strengths. I type, Eddie Blackwell fixes potholes, sort of thing! The Committee have driven the Club Championships from a competitor's point of view to ensure continued competition and interest, the whole lot collated by the irrepressible Pat Jones.

With the Club winning the ANWCC Club Championship for the first time and the getting second in the MSA Club of the Year it is fair to describe me as "chuffed to little mint balls". I can only thank the members & committee of Clwyd Vale and the friends of the Club for their help and goodwill over the last six years. Apologies for not mentioning everyone, good luck to my successor, Guy, and thanks for the last six years.

Farrington 26/27 November 2005

The Farrington Road Rally ran on 26/27 November 2005 with some 59 crews tackling the 150 mile route starting from Deeside Industrial Estate. The run out took the crews to Rhualt where the start of the 3 sections into petrol saw every car dropping time at both the intermediate and finish controls. At arrival at first petrol the lead was held by car 1 of Baz Green and Rob Jones with a close battle for second between Tony Gush and Owen Dodd and Gareth 'Shonkey' Jones and Brynmor Pierce with the Subaru of Ian Lloyd in close proximity followed by car 10 of Mei Jones and Gwawr Hughes.

First petrol halt held at Loggerheads Garage saw the crews then move off to the now infamous farmyards section up above Llysfasi College where quickest on 2 minutes 20 seconds was Ian Lloyd closely followed by Gareth Shonkey Jones and Dave Jones on 2 minutes 23 seconds and Baz Green and Tony Gush on 2 minutes 26 seconds. The remaining part of section 4 was cleaned by the crews.

Section 5 started on the outskirts of Pwll Glas and finished by Rhewl. It saw all crews dropping time at the first intermediate and the finish control. Then into second petrol at the Esso station courtesy of Mr David Evans ready for the long 60 mile section to finish which had 11 intermediate clocks. The careful placing of the clocks and marshals saw the crews drop time at 7 of the intermediate clocks including the finish clock, and a number of the top crews were caught out for early penalties at RTC6J including cars 1, 4 and 7. This had a major impact on the results meaning that Baz

Green who lead the event from the start received a 3 minute 32 second penalty at this control for being over 1½ minutes early dropped them down to 3rd overall.

The event finished at the Faenol Fawr where the complex nature of the regularity sections used saw the results take longer to resolve. There were also issues relating to check sheets that were returned, and following a meeting of the stewards, using all the information available, the winners were declared as Ian Lloyd and Cyril Jones.

Guy Woodcock and the other organisers would like to thank all the marshals involved for their help and assistance and all club members for their contributions. Special thanks goes to all those marshals that turned up and manned two controls on what was not the warmest of nights but at least it stayed dry.

Big personal thanks from Guy Woodcock to the main organising committee for their help, assistance and putting up with his miserable grumpy moods especially when the photocopier broke!! on both the Thursday and Saturday night when last minute amendments were needed to be made to some paperwork.

The event is now back in the very early planning stages for 2006 with the date being 25/26 November. The intention is to run a similar format to last year but probably only one petrol halt but certainly keeping the long section to finish which at the moment on the map is about 70 miles!

Nice big shiny Crystal trophies are on offer at the end of the year if you win a particular championship.

When competing on events points are given for Class position only, it doesn't matter where you finish overall (well apart from 1st where you get a 10 point bonus) with a 1 point bonus for starting the event, that way you at least get one point even if you don't finish.

You do get points for attending social evenings like quiz nights, play station nights, marshalling on certain events etc., these all count towards the Social, Newcomers and Gareth W Jones awards, so even if you don't compete you still have a chance of winning something.
