Do you know how to use a 'Liege' clock?

Clwyd Vale MC has promised to help by supplying some personnel to man a few controls on The Tour of Cheshire organised by Knutsford & DMC on the 5th March. As part of the HRCR Clubmans Rally Championship, the event uses 'Liege' style clocks (CD200 Rally Timing System) for control timing. We are all familiar with 'Wharton' clocks but it is important to expand our skills to be able to use these Liege clocks. They are not difficult to operate and in many respects are a lot easier than whartons but it is always useful to get your hands on one at a training session and learn how they work before that first car arrives at your control!

Knutsford have arranged a training evening on Monday 21st February and a number of our club members are going along to brush up their skills. If you would like to get involved and join a 'car share' then give Pat Jones a ring (01352 720684) and she will find you a seat in one of the cars that are going.

So finally at the end of January we got to organise the first CVMC Night Nav of the year. Setting up the route was not without drama. The staple gun failed a number of times and at one point I was grovelling under a cattle grid to extricate parts of the gun that had fallen off! Five crews turned up on the night to have fun on some interesting lanes. The start was from Nant Mill near Coedpoeth and the route wended around the yellows to the east of Ruabon Mountain, down to Acrefair and Trevor and over World's End and Esclusham Mountain. The finish was at Moors Inn near Llandelga.

After half an hour or so of plotting the route, which consisted of a string of Map Refs and Spot Heights, crews headed off across the ford and into the frosty night. A couple of crews missed the first symbol, which was placed just before the ford!

All five crews made the finish before the 10.30pm deadline and were given an extra 10 minutes to complete "Name that Symbol". The symbols consisted of three letter abbreviations. CD200 Rally Timing (Liege)

Using the CD200 Rally Timer at a manned Regularity Start (RS)

1. BASIC INSTRUCTIONS

The car will draw up and request to start on the next whole minute.

Write the requested time on the competitor's timecard and your checksheet.

Wait until less than 30 seconds to go and then connect and hold the Memory Chip on the top of the competitor's timecard onto the Timer. The Timer will beep once and display the start time for 2 or 3 seconds. The LED will start flashing red.

The Timer beeps again at 10 seconds to go, then beeps for a countdown from 5 seconds. At zero, a long beep sounds and the LED changes from red to green. Call out the countdown to the crew.

That's it. The car can go.

3. BEWARE - THINGS TO WATCH OUT FOR

You cannot transfer the start time from the Timer to the Chip when there is less than 10 seconds to go.

If you need to abort the start and hold the competitor back until the next minute, the Chip can be reprogrammed to the Timer and the previous data will be overwritten. You must also change the timecard and checksheet.

Your Timer is pre-programmed for the function of your control and the control number and should only be used again for a subsequent control if specifically instructed. The number in the top right corner of the display (i.e. 04) is the control sequence number. Pressing the 'Esc' button should show 'St 0:30' on the display to confirm the correct functional mode for a RS control is set up.

If for any reason you cannot transfer the time to the competitor's Chip, write an 'X' in the 'LT' column on the timecard and the Results will ignore the Chip time and take the time from the timecard. Also make a note of that on your checksheet.
