Barbados Rally Carnival

To celebrate the famous Barbados Rally Carnival's tenth anniversary this year, the event has evolved into a 14-day asphalt rallying festival for historic rally cars.

The annual festival - which comprises a ralliesprint one weekend and an asphalt special-stage rally the next, with plenty of social activity in-between - has become a bit of a cult event among British and European rally drivers.

Regulations for the Barbados Historic Rally Carnival are designed to include as many enthusiasts as possible; an additional set of 'clubman' regulations for classic cars built before 1982 has been included, and Group B cars will be eligible for class positions only. The event will run during the school holiday period from 14 to 28 July.

Greg Cozier, creator of the Barbados Rally Carnival and founder of the Historic event, will visit Race Retro 2010 at Stoneleigh Park, Coventry on Friday 12 March, to help promote the event and speak with prospective competitors.

TOUR OF MULL CANCELLED

And future events until further notice. At a meeting on 4th March, Committee members of the 2300 Club decided unanimously that the Tour of Mull will not take place in October 2010. The decision will not be re-considered. Enthusiasm in the Club has been hugely reduced by the serious and potentially life-threatening problems that were encountered before, during and after the 2009 event.

There exist unresolved safety issues that expose both competitors and organisers; the competitors to risks beyond the natural hazards of Mull, and the organisers to possible litigation, which seems to be the way of the world these days in the face of the most innocent of intentions. Furthermore, the organisers have grown weary of the increasing number of negative and critical comments about their running of the event. Recent publicity has elicited huge support for the Rally, and that support is acknowledged and the Committee is very grateful for it. Sadly, it has at the same time given voice to our detractors and those who think they know better how to run the Tour of Mull.

Each member of the Committee is an unpaid volunteer, pursuing a hobby at huge cost in both time and money. The organisers make, and have always made, a massive effort to put on the very best event of which they are capable. They are proud of the fact that The Tour of Mull is very highly regarded as a motorsport and social event. There have always been problems and criticisms of one sort or another. Now the **Committee's** overwhelming feeling is that the growing difficulties and increasingly bitter, often personal, confrontations have eclipsed the pleasure gained from running the Rally.

Tunnock's, who have sponsored the Rally since 2005, fully support the Committee's decision. As well as providing financial backing for the rally, each year they have provided the Island's school children with items useful for their safety and comfort in addition to packs of their famous Caramel Wafers.

We will be reviewing our options for 2011 over the coming months. We will continue to present and fund the John Easson Award.

New MSC Chairman

The Board of the MSA has confirmed that Tony Scott Andrews has been selected to take over from Graham Stoker as Chairman of the Motor Sports Council with effect from 1 January 2010. Graham Stoker stood down following his election as FIA Deputy President for Sport.

Based in Oxfordshire, Tony has been a lawyer for 35 years and has held an MSA competition licence since 1971. He was a founder member and is now President of the Classic Saloon Car Club/Classic Touring Car Racing Club. Tony won the Pre-'57 Modified championship in an MG in 1983 and claimed championship success again in 1990 in the Pre-'65 category at the wheel of a Ford Mustang. Since then, when time allows, he has campaigned a Camaro, Falcon and most recently a Rover Vitesse in Historic Group 1 Touring Cars.

Tony is already a member of the Motor Sports Council and has chaired both the National Court and the Judicial Advisory Panel, as well as serving as a member of both the MSA Historic and Race Committees.

Challenge Events clarification

The MSA has issued a clarification of Regulation P24.2.1 to confirm that drivers in Challenge Events must hold an MSA competition licence. See Latest News section of MSA website.

Time Attack approved

The MSA now recognises the Time Attack Series as an approved form of motor sport. Originating in Japan as a way of proving the relative performance of street-tuned cars, Time Attack is a spectacular form of motor sport in which high-powered cars on road-legal tyres compete on regular motor sport circuits. www.timeattack.co.uk

New rally structure

The MSA has approved a proposal from the MSA Country Rally Championships (England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales) and the MSA British Rally Championship to create a new sporting structure and working partnership that will deliver greater benefit for the growth and development of UK rallying.

A working group, consisting of one representative from each of the five championships, has committed to work towards the future development and sustainability of UK stage rallying. Initiatives will include a reduction in the sport's environmental impact, the evolution of a recognisable sporting structure, a co-ordinate strategy for the development of junior drivers and the introduction of common policies and sporting regulations.

Racing Steps up

The Racing Steps Foundation (RSF), which helps talented young British racing drivers realise their dreams, has committed substantial support for the MSA Academy programme for young British competition drivers.

The RSF's backing enables the MSA Academy substantially to increase the reach of its existing educational programme to deliver benefit to all of the 2,000 competition licence holders aged under 17.

Trees fees rooted

The MSA has confirmed that the fees charged for providing access to the Forestry Estate for MSA-permitted rally events will remain unchanged for the 2010 season.

MSA training provider

The MSA has been appointed as one of the first two Regional Training Providers by the FIA Institute for Motor Sport Safety and Sustainability to help increase the safety and training standards of motor sport officials across the world.

David Butler MBE

Due to an oversight, David Butler was described in a recent statement announcing his award of the MBE in the New Year's Honours List as having established the British Motor Sport Association for the Disabled (BMSAD) in 1987. We are pleased to confirm that the founding Chairman of the BMSAD was Jack Davidson of Aberdeen and Tony Reynolds followed him. David Butler is therefore the third Chairman of the BMSAD.
