SPRINT UPDATE

After the problems at Aintree, the engine was rebuilt and in the car just in time for Loton Park, Shrewsbury.

The plan for the day was to look after the engine, keep the revs down, and not to worry about class position, as it was a round of both the ANWCC and Chester/Liverpool Championship, hopefully gain a few championship points as well.

With that said, I was surprised to find after the first timed runs, I was not only lying 3rd in class but also improved on my previous best time at Loton by over 2 seconds, may not sound a lot but an improvement is an improvement.

Unfortunately the rain came down before our next run hampering any chance of improving on 3rd, despite being the quickest of the class in the wet.

The following Sunday found us at Three Sisters, Wigan, an event run by Chester MC, also an ANWCC, Chester/Liverpool Championship round.

As with Loton, the plan was to {look after the engine}. With rain threatened for later in the day the organisers tried to minimise on delays to allow every one to have at least one dry run, leaving only time between runs to perform minor adjustments to

the car.

After the first round of timed runs I was 3rd in class, just under a second behind Paul {Skoda} Ellis of NWCC, taking a break from rallying and giving his MG Midget an airing. On the next set of timed runs I found that second, only to find Paul had beaten me to 2nd place by 0.02 seconds.

3rd in class on two consecutive weekends, I will have to try a bit harder next time.

Next was a return to *#! Aintree. {in the rain}. It rained nearly all day, leaving the track like a river in places.

Keeping it steady and improving as the track started too dry-out netted a 2nd in class at the end of the day.

For me that's the end of the season.

I won't know how I have faired in the championships until all the rounds have been completed but at the moment I am leading the classic class and still may win best in Chester in the Chester/Liverpool Championship as well as leading class Bb in the ANWCC Championship.
