Driver Jon "Wol" Whalley and I entered the **Glyn Memorial Rally** at Anglesey Circuit with the "Purple Moose" Escort last weekend. We did both days but came a fairly hopeless **23rd (8th in Class D)**. A brief spell of rain on the stages after dark on Saturday night demonstrated to us that we needed better wet weather tyres. There was a good entry of around 75 cars including the Juniors. If I'm honest, we were outclassed by the opposition but the Service Crew did a good job, including a high-speed repair to the starter-motor and an equally rapid alternator swap. This did at least allow us to finish the event, which seemed to have quite a high attrition rate.

Vale of Clwyd Classic

The event will run on **Saturday 3rd September 2011** based in the Ruthin area and will comprise of 4 or 5 regularity sections and between 8 and 10 special tests. The organising club and officials have been involved in organising road rallies for over 20 years and most recently with the Farrington Trophy Rally have achieved numerous awards from both the ANWCC and WAMC of motor clubs, culminating in 2009 when the event won Best event in Wales and the North West Regions.

Clerk of the Course, Guy Woodcock, has been competing on HRCR and other regularity events over the last few years and has planned a route to tax both driver and navigator. Route instructions will be issued at various stages throughout the event but realistically the majority of the plotting will be able to be done prior to the start of the relevant regularity section.

It is proposed that the event will run a maximum of 50 cars, although should a greater number of entries be received then we will consider increasing this number, although the proposed start and finish venue may give issues if the numbers exceed this significantly. We are likely to be able to offer scrutineering and signing on both the Friday night and early Saturday morning with the event starting at 8.30 a.m. with the first car due at the finish at approximately 4.30, having covered approximately 120 miles and the 8-10 special tests which will be a mixture of farm tracks, stately homes, car parks etc.

The entry fee will fall in line with the majority of the 1 day events run in the HRCR championship and will include lunch and supper.

Night Navigation Exercise – 29th Oct 2010

The final Night Nav of the club year was organised by Peter Williams and Brian Howatson and started from a dark and dank lay-by near Whitford. However only 5 crews turned up to do "battle" on the yellows between Mostyn and Bodfari.

The organisers craftily removed all copies of map 116 from the experts although the one novice crew were allowed to keep theirs. This was a Navigation Exercise with a difference! The crews were each given a beautifully prepared Road Book with lots of Tulip diagrams. It was a bit like a stage event but without any indication as to distances between junctions.

Off we headed into the unknown! It was a little disconcerting not having a map on lap although we were given sealed envelopes with copies of bits of 116 if we were to get lost. This presumably would help us find our way back to the finish venue if nothing else but a large penalty would be given for opening said envelopes.

Along the route we had to record various things including BT kiosk phone numbers, public house names and name of licensees plus a few letter symbols. A few arrows as on a proper stage rally would have been nice or perhaps a few more symbols if only to confirm we were on the correct route.

We made it to the finish in Afonwen with 5 minutes to spare where the results were announced swiftly. Jan and Graham Thomas found it a tough event but still managed to win and clinch the Expert Championship for the year with Tina and myself winning the Novice Championship (subject to confirmation) Andy Darlington and daughter Louise (aged 13) enjoyed their first navigation run together despite Louise feeling a bit ill towards the end.

Thanks to the organisers for an enjoyable test of our navigational skills and wits!

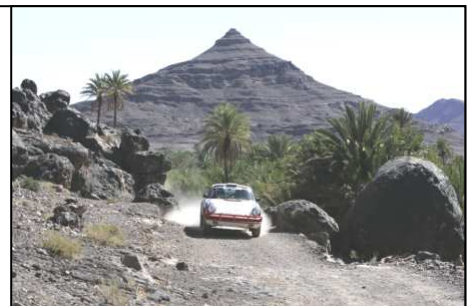

The MSA Technical Department advises that there is no mandatory requirement for Bonnet Pins to be fitted to Stage Rally cars. However, vehicles in all disciplines must comply with General Regulation (J)5.20.2, which states that all vehicles must 'have positive fastenings for all doors and all hinged or detachable parts of the bodywork'.

The MSA Licensing Department advises that Competitor Renewal Forms will be sent out in mid-November to those who held a licence in 2009 or 2010. The Department also wishes to remind competitors that as of 1 December 2010 they can apply online for their 2011 licences (subject to terms and conditions) and thus ensure that their application will be processed within seven days.
