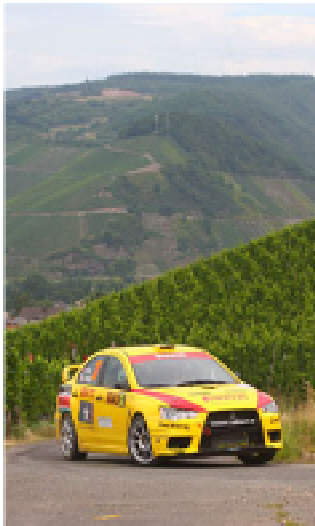
Car 37, Peter Horsey / Calvin Cooledge,

Porthmadog Autobodys Ranges Stages

14th August 2010, Jonathan Whalley / Peter Dennis - Car 7



"The Ranges sheep had invested heavily in creating a spectacular rally and left a substantial deposit on the first stages. Running higher up the order than usual, we were amazed at how little grip there was on the wet, slimy surface and made an inauspicious start by going off over some tyres on Stage 1, trapping one underneath, which acted like a tumbler, causing us to go off again. Wol missing his braking-point for the triangle on one stage and the chicane on another didn't help. When the car returned to service, one of the half-bumpers was hanging off and the spoiler needed re-attaching on the off-side. This involved drilling a new hole and forcing the edge of the spoiler at a new angle - "adding more front wing" as they'd say in F1!"

"With new X22 tyres after SS 3 we began to claw our way back from a disastrous result, setting some improved times in the afternoon, including a 4th fastest on one Stage"

"Despite the reduced entry, it was a fun, well organized event and the Purple Moose (our sponsor) was pleased with the 2nd in Class trophy/7th overall and even happier when the whole team bought a load of his beer at a party later that evening. Unusually, good-luck was shining on us that weekend and the icing on the cake was winning the prize draw, which refunded the entry fee: a welcome incentive for a low-budget team"

When I retired at Petrol on the 2009 Farrington I actually thought that was the last time for the next few years I'd be sitting in a rally car, to the point that I put my licence renewal in the recycling. However over the last 9 months I'd started to hanker after having a spin again and then a chance conversation at the PK with Gareth Price saw me team up with John-Paul Williams in the Impreza for the Gogledd, which was also a return after a sabbatical for him.

Last years Gogledd was home ground for me but this year being mainly centred around Abergele, I could almost have been anywhere in Wales. The route plotted nicely with what looked like a great selection of lanes mixed in with whites. Off from the start of RS1 I knew I was in for a good night as it became obvious that JP is one hell of a driver, the two main real issues we experienced in the first half was the engine cutting out at some junctions and slightly intermittent brakes on RS2!! A cracking result for JP which many have told me has been on the cards for some time now, I can say it was an absolute pleasure to sit next to such a class driver all night and what a fun event RDMC ran along with spot on marshalling all night. So retirement over when's the next event!!

IRISH RALLY DEFINITIONS

- 1) **Reece:** Chance for the lunatics to look for an accident site and to look for places to park stealth chase cars (see 13) On road sections.

LATVALA TO DRIVE 'MONSTER' FORD FOCUS RS WRC AT RALLYDAY

Rallyday confirms that BP Ford Abu Dhabi World Rally Team driver Jari-Matti Latvala will pilot Ken Block's Monster World Rally Team Ford Focus RS WRC at this year's tenth anniversary Show, at Wiltshire's Castle Combe Circuit on Saturday 18 September.

"The opportunity to drive the Ford Focus RS WRC on asphalt at Castle Combe is something I am looking forward to, away from the pressures of competition. I hope I can put on a really good show for the fans, with lots of sideways action and I'm sure the event will be as big a success as it has been in previous years," commented Latvala.

Rallyday organisers, Brian Stubbings and Darin Frow are both delighted that the Finn has agreed to attend the UK's premier rally car show and drive the M-Sport-built car which Block drove recently in Germany.

"It is brilliant for us to welcome Jari-Matti to the show, driving the same Ford Focus RS WRC car driven in the World Rally Championship by Ken Block," Stubbings said. "Block took the award for 'Most Thrilling Driver' at the Goodwood Festival of Speed back in July and I'm sure Jari-Matti will be equally thrilling in front of the Rallyday crowds in a few weeks!"

Latvala is one of a number of rally celebrities already confirmed for the event, with 1984 World Rally Champion Stig Blomqvist also returning to mark the 30th anniversary of the Audi quattro. As part of this celebration, a comprehensive line-up of original works Audi quattros will be in the centre of the Rallyday paddock, covering their evolution through the 1980s and Blomqvist will be back behind the wheel to bring some nostalgic memories of this amazing era of the sport.

In addition, the Rallyday team is delighted to welcome a new manufacturer to the event: Skoda UK announced recently that two-time British Rally Champion, Guy Wilks will drive the new Skoda Fabia S2000 Facelift, which the Englishman got his first taste of last weekend on the Barum Czech Rally Zlin, the latest round in the 2010 FIA Intercontinental Rally Challenge.

"Rallyday at Castle Combe is a really good event, with a fantastic atmosphere. There is always a great collection of rally cars, both modern and from a bygone era, and the access people have to the cars and drivers is second to none. I really love driving at Rallyday," said Wilks.

"Although Castle Combe is a race circuit, it's a great opportunity to put on a show for the large crowd of spectators - especially as there are so many of them!"

1977 and 1985 British Rally Champion, Russell Brookes, his co-drivers, Mike Broad, John Brown, Paul White, Neil Wilson and Peter Bryant and original sponsor John Andrews will all be there as part of a special Andrews Heat for Hire Celebration. Spectators will be able to view the range of iconic rally cars which Brookes used over his successful long-term campaign.

"This year's Rallyday is special for me," said Brookes. "The 70s and 80s were the most exciting years for British rallying and throughout this period, I had a unique partnership with Andrews Heat for Hire, who sponsored me for 17 of those years. Their bright yellow livery epitomised this exciting era and Rallyday is bringing together over a dozen original rally cars - from Mk2 Ford Escorts, through Chevetttes, Sunbeam Lotus, Opel Mantas and the 400bhp Sierra Cosworths among others.

Many of co-drivers of the cars will be joining us on the stand of what will be a unique display, one which is unlikely ever to be repeated. See you there."

1996 British Rally Championship winner Gwyndaf Evans and three-times Fiesta Sport Trophy championship winner Elfyn Evans will be at the show, with a display from Gwyndaf Evans Motors. The display will feature several rally cars Gwyndaf has campaigned, including Seat F2 and Sierra Cosworth - plus Elfyn's latest Fiesta R2, along with new cars from the family-run Ford and Suzuki dealership.

Indeed, several stars from the World Rally Championship have already signed up for Rallyday 2010, including Phil Mills (Petter Solberg's co-pilot until June this year); Nicky Grist (who co-drove for the late Colin McRae); and, of course, Rallyday host extraordinaire, 1972 RAC winning co-driver (with Roger Clark) and former Top Gear presenter Tony Mason.

The action doesn't stop there either, with Russ Swift returning to entertain the crowds with his spectacular precision driving display, as well as the Strictly Sideways Competition, a special Rallycross demonstration - including competitors from the very competitive one-make Suzuki Swift class and the RX150 buggies.

The Richard Bums Foundation is back in force, too, and will display six of the original works cars which span the career of the late 2001 World Rally Champion. McRae Vision will also have a presence, with fans getting the chance to see the 1995 World Rally Champions' original Ford Sierra Cosworth and the McRae R4. There will be an opportunity to participate in the latest Colin McRae Dirt game and to buy a range of McRae merchandise as well.

"We've pulled out all the stops this year and are delighted with the incredible line up of cars and stars coming to help us celebrate Rallyday's tenth anniversary. We also hope to make more exciting announcements shortly!" Frow concluded.
