



## **Club Championship Regulations**

**1<sup>st</sup> November 2011 - 31<sup>st</sup> October 2012**

1. Clwyd Vale Motor Club will promote, during 2011 / 2012 a number of Championships for its members. Details of the Championships are given in the following pages. The Championships will run from the 1<sup>st</sup> November 2011 to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2012
2. These regulations cancel and supersede all previous championship regulations of the Clwyd Vale Motor Club and all Club members will be assumed to be familiar with their content.
3. All the Championships are open to all fully elected, paid-up members of the Clwyd Vale Motor Club and points will not be allocated until subscriptions have been paid. Points will only be awarded from that time. Points will not be awarded retrospectively. Points will be scored for competing in qualifying events in accordance with the points scoring system within these regulations, provided the entry has been made in the name of Clwyd Vale Motor Club. It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure this is done.

**It is also the competitor's responsibility to ensure that the necessary information (proof of entry and results) is received by the Competition Secretary.**

Leading places in each championship will be published in the Club Newsletter.

4. **Time limit.** It is the responsibility of the competitor to register results with the Competition Secretary within one calendar month of participating on an event, except for the end of the Championship year when the time limit will be 12.00 midnight on the last day of October 2012.
5. All Championship awards will be presented at the Annual Awards Presentation to be held after the conclusion of the Championship year. All named awards remain the property of the Clwyd Vale Motor Club and are to be returned after eleven months or on demand.
6. Any changes to these regulations will be issued through the Club Newsletter and will have the same jurisdiction as these regulations.
7. Any correspondence regarding the Championships must be addressed to the Club Competition Secretary. Any dispute to be resolved by the disputes panel.

## CHAMPIONSHIPS

### Drivers - Stage & Sporting Championships

- a. Stage Rally (To include both Forest and Tarmac rallies)
- b. Sporting (PCT, Autotest, Sprints, Hillclimb, Race, Karting, Off Road)

Events to qualify shall be all events organised by Clwyd Vale Motor Club, or events to which the Club, Association of North Western Car Clubs (ANWCC) and Welsh Association of Motor Clubs (WAMC) accept on behalf of its members, an invitation to participate, including National and International events where no club is specified or required.

A member's best 8 results shall count for each Championship.

A bonus of 10 points will be awarded should the driver finish 1<sup>st</sup> Overall

Points scoring per event will be calculated as follows: -

Class position score + 1 (one) point for starting = Total score, plus 10 points for an Overall win.

### Drivers - Road Rally Championship

Events to qualify shall be all events organised by Clwyd Vale Motor Club, or events to which the Club, Association of North Western Car Clubs (ANWCC) and Welsh Association of Motor Clubs (WAMC) accept on behalf of its members, an invitation to participate, including National and International events where no club is specified or required.

A member's best 8 results shall count for each Championship.

## Navigators – Stage Rally Championship

Events to qualify shall be all events organised by Clwyd Vale Motor Club, or events to which the Club, Association of North Western Car Clubs (ANWCC) and Welsh Association of Motor Clubs (WAMC) accept on behalf of its members, an invitation to participate, including National and International events where no club is specified or required. A member's best 8 results shall count for each Championship.

Points scoring per event will be calculated as follows: -  
Class position score + 1 (one) point for starting = Total score, plus 10 points for an Overall win.

## Navigators – Road Rally Championship

Events to qualify shall be all events organised by Clwyd Vale Motor Club, or events to which the Club, Association of North Western Car Clubs (ANWCC) and Welsh Association of Motor Clubs (WAMC) accept on behalf of its members, an invitation to participate, including National and International events where no club is specified or required. A member's best 8 results shall count for each Championship.

Points scoring per event will be calculated as follows: -  
Class position score + Overall Position + 1 (one) point for starting = Total score.

### **Note 1**

Club members competing on all events must enter under Clwyd Vale Motor Club in order to receive Championship points.

Proof of this will be a copy of the entry form with Clwyd Vale Motor Club shown as the competitors club. This applies to all relevant Championships.

Class points will be awarded in the position you finish on the road regardless of how the overall trophies are awarded, i.e. If you finish 3<sup>rd</sup> Expert overall and the 1<sup>st</sup> two crews received 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> overall awards you will be awarded points for 3<sup>rd</sup> in class.

Clwyd Vale members competing on closed to club Road Rallies organised by another club will be eligible for Championship points.

However, Club members competing on all other events must enter under Clwyd Vale Motor Club in order to receive Championship points.

### **Night Navigational Exercise Championship – Divided into four Championships**

- a. Expert Drivers
- b. Expert Navigators
- c. Novice Drivers
- d. Novice Navigators

Events to qualify shall be all the Night Navigational Exercises organised by the Club during the Championship year. Points scoring, as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> Overall – 35 Points	7 <sup>th</sup> Overall – 19 Points
2 <sup>nd</sup> Overall – 30 Points	8 <sup>th</sup> Overall – 18 Points
3 <sup>rd</sup> Overall – 25 Points	9 <sup>th</sup> Overall – 17 Points
4 <sup>th</sup> Overall – 23 Points	10 <sup>th</sup> Overall – 16 Points
5 <sup>th</sup> Overall – 21 Points	11 <sup>th</sup> Overall – 15 Points
6 <sup>th</sup> Overall – 20 Points	12 <sup>th</sup> Overall – 14 points

Points will only be awarded to one Driver and one Navigator per car.

A competitor's best 9 scores (from 11 events) shall count for the Championship.

### **Social Championship**

To include – Club Social Evening Nominated Events, Gymkanas, Table Top Rallies and such events as may be organised from time to time as notified in the newsletter.

Marshalling on MSA or FIA authorised Motorsport events.

#### **Points Scoring System for the Social Championship**

Club Social Evening Events, Gymkanas, Table Top Rallies, and such events as may be organised from time to time as notified in the newsletter. -

Overall Positions	1 <sup>st</sup> Overall = 35 points
	2 <sup>nd</sup> Overall = 30 points
	3 <sup>rd</sup> Overall = 25 points

Organising a Clwyd Vale Motor Club event: 20 points.

Acting as named Official on a Clwyd Vale Motor Club event: 20 points.

Marshalling on MSA or FIA authorised Motorsport events: 10 points per event.

### **Marshals Championship**

Marshalling on MSA or FIA authorised Motorsport events.

#### **Points Scoring System for the Marshals Championship**

10 points per event.

## Overall Club Champion

This trophy is awarded as a tribute to former Secretary, Gareth W Jones, and goes to the club member who takes pride in getting involved with the club and its activities and is a measure of effort and not results in the various qualifying disciplines. The Club Champion will be the person who accumulates the highest number of points, as per the scoring system below, in all of the Club Championships, provided of course, that entries have been made in the name of the Club. See note 1.

Points will be awarded as follows:

- 1) Finishing any event in the Drivers - Stage, Sporting or Road Rally Championships or Navigators – Stage or Road Rally Championship will receive 15 points + 1 point for starting (any member who does not finish the event will receive 1 point towards this championship). A maximum of 8 results will be entered into this championship.
- 2) Taking part in any CVMC Night Navigational Exercise – 10 points. A maximum of 9 results will be entered into this championship.
- 3) Taking part in any event as detailed in the Social championship – 10 points.
- 4) Organising or acting as a named official on any CVMC event – 20 points.

## Newcomers Championship

A Newcomer is a person who has not been a member of Clwyd Vale Motor Club at any time previously. (Except as a Junior Member). The highest placed Newcomer during the championship year will be the competitor who joined the Club during the year and who accumulates the highest number of points in all of the Club Championships, provided, of course, that entries have been made in the name of the Club. See note 1.

Note: For those Newcomers entering Road Rally events, their points will be calculated as follows:  
Class position score + Overall Position + 1 (one) point for starting = Total score ÷ 2, i.e. if you score 80 points in the Road Rally Drivers or Road Rally Navigators championships, your points carried into the Newcomers Championship will be 40.

This is to offset the fact that Stage & Sporting Drivers and Stage Navigators do not obtain points for their Overall position and ensures there is no unfair advantage to Road Rally competitors.

## Junior Championships

The aim of these championships is to encourage Junior members to participate in events as they become eligible in line with the MSA Yearbook age limits.

A Junior member is as defined in the Club Rules item 19, paragraph 4. The Full member (parent / guardian) who nominates the Junior member on their Membership Application Form will be wholly responsible for the safety, security and reasonable behaviour of that Junior member.

The Championships will open to Junior members when they reach the age of 5. Junior Membership and eligibility for the Junior Championship will cease on the member's 17<sup>th</sup> birthday, regardless of Club Year start & finish. Points gained before the member's 17<sup>th</sup> birthday will stand in the Junior Championship. The Club Secretary will record the date of the Junior member's 5th birthday.

Point scoring will be in line with all other appropriate Club Championships. Additionally Junior members from age 12 onwards will be able to gain points for being a passenger on a Production Car Trial or Production Car Autotest at a rate of half the points gained for their driver.

Junior Members will be eligible for all other Club Championships except the Newcomers Championship. All members between the ages of 5 and 16 may only claim points for marshalling on events organised by Clwyd Vale Motor Club.

Two awards will be presented:

**Junior Club Champion** - any Junior member who falls into the 12 to 16 age bracket who accumulates the highest number of points from any event for which they are eligible.

**Best Mini** - any Junior member who falls into the 5 to 11 age bracket who accumulates the highest number of points from social events held within the club.

Any junior member who turns 12 in the championship year will continue receiving points for the mini championship for social events, however, should they compete on events which they become eligible for after reaching the age of 12 these points will then be entered into the Junior Championship.
